

Steps

- 1 | **Connect Ethernet cable to Magic Box**
- 2 | Connect power adapter
- 3 | Connect Ethernet cable to router
- 4 | View status indicator color
- 5 | Troubleshoot connection status



Step 1

Connect Ethernet cable to Magic Box

Connect one end of the included Ethernet cable to the port on the Magic Box labeled *ETH*. Then plug the other end of the cord into an open Ethernet port on your router.

- 2 | **Connect power adapter**
- 3 | Connect Ethernet cable to router
- 4 | View status indicator color
- 5 | Troubleshoot connection status



Step 2

Connect power adapter

Connect the round power adapter to the Magic Box and plug into wall outlet.

- 2 | Connect power adapter
- 3 | **Connect Ethernet cable to router**
- 4 | View status indicator color
- 5 | Troubleshoot connection status



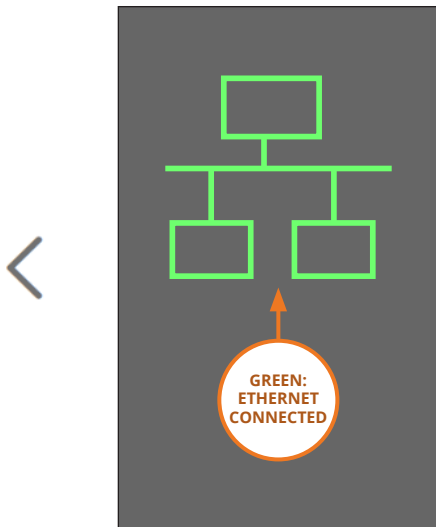
Step 3

Connect Ethernet cable to router

Connect the other end of the cable to any open Ethernet port on your router.

Steps

- 1 | Connect Ethernet cable to Magic Box
- 2 | Connect power adapter
- 3 | Connect Ethernet cable to router
- 4 | **View status indicator color**
- 5 | Troubleshoot connection status



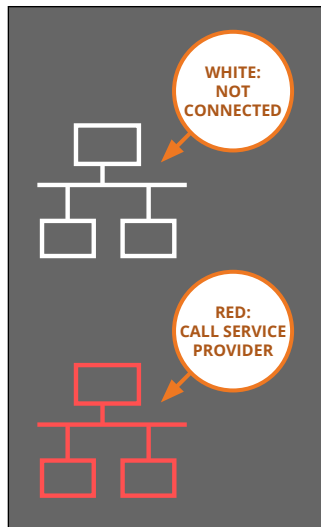
Step 4

View status indicator color

If the status indicator for the network connection at the top center of the screen displays as *pale green*, skip the next step. Your terminal is now successfully connected and ready to use.

Step 5

Troubleshoot connection status
